CHAMPIONSHIPS

All dancers in championship competitions up to and **including U14** should be prepared to dance 3 at a time. **Schedule will not run in age order.** Rotations will be computer-generated by FeisWeb. A dancer who misses his/her rotation will not be permitted to dance. Hard shoe rounds will be danced first.

Girls/Ladies and Boys/Men will be combined in both Prelim and Open Championships.

Changes to dances may be made until February 18, 2024, without penalty. Changes after February 18th up to February 25th <u>must be submitted with a change fee of \$10</u>*. **NO CHANGE of dances allowed after February 25th or on the day of the Feis, except for mandatory moves from Prelim to Open.**
